Massena: William H. "Buddy" Bero, 86, passed away Monday evening, Jan. 2, 2017 at the Massena Memorial Hospital. Burial will take place in the spring at St. Patrick's Cemetery in Hogansburg.

Buddy was born on December 8, 1930 in Hogansburg, NY the son of Daniel and Katherine (Savage) Bero. He graduated from Bombay High School. William was employed with the US Postal Service as Post Master in the Hogansburg Post Office for 12 years. After that he worked construction and later drove cab for City Cab of Plattsburgh. Buddy enjoyed the time he spent with his family, especially his grandchildren, making sure to attend as many of their sporting events as possible. He also liked watching stock car racing and being around the fire with friends.

Buddy is survived by his companion of 12 years, Patricia Spossey; his children, Jo Ellen Bero and companion Dawn Buffham of Massena, Marcia Bero and companion Shondel Boyden of Colton, NY, William "Jack" Bero, Michael Bero and Steven Bero all of Massena; 7 grandchildren; five great grandchildren and a brother Bernard Bero of Hogansburg. He was predeceased by a son, Francis and six brothers.
